Interclub Competitions and Guidelines

2020 Season Updated February 2020

Interclub Competition is one of the benefits of membership. It is the opportunity to qualify for competition against other clubs in Zone 5 (South Vancouver Island) of the B.C. Golf Association (Golf BC). For current standings in interclub competition and an overview of the competition format, visit the Zone 5 Men's Golf website. Participating Zone 5 clubs, in addition to Cordova Bay, currently include Uplands, Victoria, Olympic View, Royal Colwood, Gorge Vale, Cedar Hill, Duncan Meadows, Arbutus Ridge, Cowichan and Bear Mountain.

The Zone 5 Men's Executive Committee runs the following events:

- Willie Park – No handicap competition, for close to scratch golfers (suggested handicap under 6), six play each week
- Harry Young – Handicapped competition for golfers generally in 6-18 range, six play each week (April through July)
- Senior Interclub – A handicapped event for players 55 plus, six play each week (May through July)
- Lawrie Kerr (formerly Senior Buttons) – Gross match play for low handicappers 55 plus, four-member team playing each week
- Winter Buttons – A non-handicapped competition (October through April) with a two-member team that may include one club professional. By custom at Cordova Bay, the low gross stroke play winner and runner-up at the Men's Club Championship have first option to form the Winter Buttons

The interclub Coordinator of Cordova Bay Men's Club role is to provide a competitive and fun team for each of the events. A small bucket of range balls is complementary for home and away teams at Cordova Bay. (Annual pass members pay no golf costs)

Registration:

- Cordova Bay GC will place a registration link here (PLACE LINK HERE) for all members; if you wish to qualify for a team, you will need to register and pay an additional \$10 for each team you are attempting to qualify for
- If you are attempting to qualify for more than one team, you will list in order your preference. i.e. 1- Willie Park, 2-Harry Young, 3-Senior, etc.
- You are able to play on multiple teams providing a team can't field enough players. Preference will be given to members who have paid to qualify
- Registrants to release personal email and phone number to Interclub Coordinator and Team Captain

Qualifying dates run from March 16 – April 6, 2020 inclusive.

- Best 3 of 4 rounds to be used for qualifying (Stableford scoring in effect)
- Before your round, email interclub@telus.net
- Once you have emailed, you have deemed this round to be one of your qualifying scores
- Please ensure you return your scorecard to the drop box at the end of your round because if no score card is found, this will still be used as a qualifying round
- You must play with a member and have them attest your score card as well as having the date and your name clearly printed on it
- All qualifying rounds will be played from the blue tees unless otherwise designated

Once Qualified

- The Interclub Coordinator will offer the Team Captain's position by way of committee choice for each team. The Team Captain is responsible for organizing a team for each event, picking the starting order (when applicable), advising the course of which member's played (for billing), contacting the Zone 5 representative about the results of a home match, and ensuring the team represents Cordova Bay with integrity, sportsmanship and a desire to win. Above all – have fun!
- Interclub Coordinator will send emails to all qualifiers and (non-qualifiers) introducing Team Captains, Zone 5 website, cost and schedule (if available)
- Team members to confirm availability ASAP for entire season

Harry Young / Senior Interclub – additional guidelines

- 11 members per team
- First Match – top 6 available qualifiers
- Other Matches – you will remain on the roster for the next match if you win your individual match (team matches not included for continuation).
- If you lose or tie your match, you will go to the bottom of the rotation in the same order as you qualified
- Should a player not be available for the next match, that person goes to the bottom of the rotation
- Exception – If you are not scheduled to play, then asked to fill in and unable, you will not lose your place in the rotation
- Team Captain to play all matches (if available)
- Team Captain to choose an Assistant Captain
