BOOKING POLICY CHANGE

Revised Booking Rules - Read carefully

For all tee times beginning May 22 the following conditions apply:

Players will not be allowed on property more than 20 minutes before scheduled time.

We will book players to form groups of four. If you are not comfortable being paired, please contact the pro shop by phone where you will be able to secure a time for your players only. 18 hole options available between 2 – 4 pm and after 5 pm for 9 holes.

The player reserving the tee time accepts full responsibility for payment of all fees and no show fees.

At this time, bookings will be limited to a maximum of 4 players per reservation. Groups of more than 4 players will need to reserve separate times for each group. We cannot guarantee tee times will be in sequence.

We require names for all players in your booking. Players whose names are not on the tee sheet, will not be granted access to the facility by our gate attendant.

Players must read the Safety Protocols included in the confirmation, specifically arrival time and outline of the services currently available.

Web Booking will be active as of 7 am on Friday May 8th.
