

OP36 APRIL JUNIOR GOLF FAQ

Q: What is Operation 36?

A: OP36 is a lesson program designed to grow with your junior golfer as they improve! Each week we will cover a new topic, with time for individualized learning for those at different levels. Our very last session will be a round at the Ridge Course, with the chance to score 36 or better from your current level. All new students start from level 1 (25 yards away)



Q: When does registration open?

A: For new OP36 students, registration opens **February 3rd @ 7 AM**

For returning students, registration will be available on January 20th

Q: How long does this program run?

A: This program will run from April 7th or 8th to April 28th or 29th depending on which class you choose. **Each class meets twice per week!**

Q: Where can I find the detailed schedule?

A: Within each registration page, you can **click on the 'Schedule' tab** in the middle of the page. There is a detailed breakdown of each session within that class!

Q: Where does each class meet?

A: Most sessions will meet at the Ridge Course, **except for sessions 3 and 5**, which will meet at the Bay Course driving range

Q: How much does the class cost?

A: Each program is **\$249 + tax**, to be paid at the time of registration

Q: Can my child continue beyond April in the OP36 program?

A: Yes! We will have **4** new program offerings in **May and June** respectively. Registration for those will be available 2 months ahead of the first session.

Q: My child has done OP36 before. Do they need to attend the orientation again?

A: Nope! If your child has done OP36 before, they do not need to attend orientation again. All new students must attend the orientation session. Orientation is the first class of each new session.

Q: Can my child borrow golf clubs?

A: Of course! Please let Kat know if your child needs golf clubs after registering and we will make it happen.

Q: How many sessions are in this program?

A: This program has 7 sessions, including the orientation session.

Q: Who is coaching this program?

A: PGA of Canada professional Kat Hodgson will be coaching all programs!

Q: How do I register my child for this program?

A: Returning students should look out for an email from Kat on January 20th, 2026. New students may use the links above to register on February 3rd, 2026, at 7 AM
