

Irrigation Project Update | April 17, 2026

The crew is back on **Hole 18**, continuing the grand underground symphony of pipes, progress, and the occasional muddy boot. Today's work mirrors yesterday, with backfilling underway on both the **10-inch and 6-inch mainline**, along with drainage repairs wherever surprises pop up beneath the surface.

Looking ahead:

- Work continues tomorrow, so **Hole #18 remains a par 3**.
- On **Sunday**, the team will install the **4-inch mainline toward the green and in front of the temporary tees**.
- As a result, **Hole #18 will be closed on Sunday**.

What golfers need to know:

- **No holes closed on April 18**
- **Hole #18 closed on April 19**
- **Hole #18 currently playing as a par 3**
- **Starting hole remains #1**

A friendly but firm nudge:

Hole 18 is **cart path only until you reach the tee markers**. We've had a few adventurous souls wander into active trench areas. While we admire the pioneering spirit, the construction zone is not part of the course routing. Please steer clear for everyone's safety... including your own scorecard.
