Enter Master Casey "Digger" Rivers, who will be positioning his excavator along the edge of the pond (likely perched atop a small museum of previously donated golf balls). The mission: reinforce the bank in front of the green, which has been quietly sabotaged over the years by muskrats and heavy traffic.

The hopeful outcome:

- A more level, forgiving area around the green
