The mainline connection between the 18th tee and 11th tee is now complete, which means Hole #15 is back open for business. A welcome return to something resembling normal golf.

Next up in the construction parade:

Hole #10 steps into the spotlight, with work beginning today around the green.

What golfers need to know:

- Hole #10 remains open today, playing to a temporary green in front of the pond (strategic? debatable. memorable? absolutely). One thing for certain ... one less pond to negotiate
- Beginning Saturday, crews will begin plowing lines from green to tee on #10.
- This phase will take approximately 3–4 days, during which Hole #10 will be closed.
- Hole #12 will step in as the optional "2-for-1" hole while #10 takes a brief vacation.

As always, updates will continue to flow daily across the usual channels.
