

Hydration Domination – Phase 2

We're pleased to announce that Phase 2 of Cordova Bay Golf Course's significant infrastructure improvement project begins September 8, 2026.

The project involves the complete replacement of our 35-year-old irrigation system, an important investment that reflects our ongoing commitment to continuous improvement and to keeping Cordova Bay healthy, beautiful, and enjoyable for years to come.

What to Expect During Your Round

As this work progresses, there will be occasions when irrigation construction may:

- Shorten or alter a hole
- Temporarily take a hole out of play
- Require rounds to begin from the 10th tee rather than the 1st
- Create slight changes to the course configuration from day to day

Phase 2 will be active from September 8 through the fall, weather permitting.

We recognize that this work may occasionally disrupt your round. In recognition of this, discounted green fees will be offered during the project.

For golfers who simply have to play all 18 holes, we will also offer an optional alternate hole played to a temporary green when required.

Where the Work Is Happening

The initial scope of Phase 2 will be on our front nine and focus on the 'clubhouse side' of the creek. Holes 1,2 fairway, 8,9, and the 7th green

In addition to the irrigation replacement, our Maintenance Team will undertake the renovation and redesign of the 1st and 9th tees. These improvements are designed to enhance the playability, presentation, and beauty of Cordova Bay.

The current target for these tee projects is late September and early October.

When a hole is out of play, an optional hole will be set up on hole 7 or hole 12. The starter will inform you prior to play.

Stay Up to Date

Because conditions and hole configurations may change throughout the project, we encourage all golfers to check for the latest information before their round.

Our “Today at the Bay” updates will provide the latest game-day information, while weekly irrigation project updates will be posted under the Irrigation Updates tab on our website.
